Executive Summary

CBP is America's frontline border security agency. With nearly 65,000 dedicated employees, CBP operates around the clock to prevent the entry of inadmissible persons and contraband into the United States at and between our Nation's POEs, while promoting the safe and efficient flow of travel and commerce into the United States. CBP remains committed to performing its mission with integrity and professionalism and to ensuring that every individual in its custody is treated with humanity and dignity.

CBP officers welcome international travelers into the United States daily. When screening foreign visitors and returning U.S. citizens, CBP uses various techniques to ensure that global tourism remains safe and strong. CBP's Office of Field Operations (OFO) inspects all travelers and their belongings at POEs. CBP conducts border inspections to determine the travelers' admissibility into the United States, to determine whether the traveler is bringing items into the United States contrary to law, and to identify threats to border security.

Border inspections begin with primary inspection. In some instances, a traveler may be referred for additional scrutiny, which is a continuation of the border inspection and is known as secondary inspection. Individuals, including U.S. citizens who are suspected of violating or are found to have violated U.S. law may be held in custody for further appropriate processing. Available CBP data indicate that, between May 1, 2021, and April 30, 2022, OFO held 302 U.S. citizens (160 adults and 142 minors) in custody at a POE longer than 24 hours.



U.S. Citizens Held in CBP Custody

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I. Legislative Language

This document was compiled pursuant to direction set forth in House Report 117-87, which accompanies the Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Appropriations Act (P.L. 117-103).

House Report 117-87 states:

Additionally, CBP shall continue to follow the directive in House Report 116–180 related to the following according to the previously directed timeframes unless otherwise specified:...

... (2) U.S. Citizens Held in CBP Custody;...

House Report 117-87 references House Report 116-180, which accompanies the FY 2020 DHS Appropriations Act (P.L. 116-93) and states:

U.S. Citizens Held in CBP Custody.—The Committee directs CBP to provide a detailed report within 90 days of the date of enactment of this Act on the number of U.S. citizens detained for more than 24 hours at POEs during the last two fiscal years. The report should include the ages of the individuals detained, the length of detention, and the rationale for their detention.

II. Background

Generally, a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) officer conducts a border inspection by interviewing travelers, by inspecting travel documents, and by using CBP systems to run queries to ensure that: (1) travelers and their baggage are admissible; (2) travelers are not wanted by a law enforcement agency; and (3) travelers do not pose a health, safety, or national security risk if admitted into the United States.

CBP officers at primary inspection have broad discretion to refer travelers for secondary inspection, with or without suspicion. Some reasons that a traveler may be referred for secondary inspection include: (1) if CBP officers at primary inspection believe, at their discretion, that further inspection is needed; (2) if CBP officers at primary inspection are alerted to an issue that may require further inspection; (3) to address issues with the documentation and/or information supplied; (4) to address potential administrative immigration violations and/or criminal violations; or (5) to screen at random. At the secondary inspection location, CBP officers will conduct further assessment to resolve the reason for the referral.

CBP's Office of Field Operations (OFO) has the authority to inspect all persons, baggage, and merchandise entering the United States.¹ During these inspections, any individual, including a U.S. citizen, who is suspected of violating or is found to have violated U.S. law may be held in custody to complete the appropriate processing. Individuals who have outstanding, extraditable warrants from other law enforcement agencies may be held pending transfer. Occasionally, CBP may inconvenience law-abiding persons while detecting, deterring, and mitigating threats to the homeland caused by individuals who are involved in illicit activities. In some instances, OFO may hold U.S. citizens who have not violated the law under certain circumstances. For example, U.S. citizens accompanying noncitizen family members may be held in custody for a limited period if they are traveling with a noncitizen family member whom OFO determines is removable and who must be processed for an appropriate administrative immigration action.

Unified Secondary (USEC) is OFO's principal secondary processing system nationwide. USEC is built on a modern platform with an intuitive user interface that unifies the functions of two CBP secondary systems, the Secure Integrated Government Mainframe Access (SIGMA) and the Consolidated Secondary Inspection System (CSIS). The requested time-in-custody data discussed in this report are housed in the SIGMA data tables, whereas the reason for initial referral or inspection is housed in the CSIS. USEC's modern platform allows OFO to continue improving and linking data systems to provide greater clarity and transparency regarding mission-critical activities.

III. Data Report

The following table includes individuals with U.S. citizenship whom OFO referred for secondary inspection and held in custody longer than 24 hours. Available CBP data indicate that, between May 1, 2021, and April 30, 2022, OFO held 302 U.S. citizens longer than 24 hours at a port of entry.

IV. Analysis/Discussion

The majority (160 of 302) of U.S. citizens whom OFO referred for secondary inspection and held in custody longer than 24 hours were adults held for criminal prosecution or adults who matched an extraditable NCIC warrant. In these cases, holding the individual is necessary for processing and transferring to the custody of another law enforcement agency.

The second most common reason (140 of 302) occurred when OFO encountered U.S. citizen minors accompanied by their inadmissible, noncitizen adult parents or legal guardians. In these cases, U.S. citizen minors are kept with their parents or legal guardians in CBP custody to maintain family unity. Holding the noncitizen parent or legal guardian beyond 24 hours is often necessary to complete immigration processing. The entire family leaves CBP custody together at the conclusion of this processing.

The third reason (2 of 302) occurred when OFO encountered U.S. citizen minors accompanied by their U.S. citizen adult parents and an inadmissible noncitizen minor. On both occasions, the U.S. citizen minor and U.S. citizen adult mother were traveling from Mexico to the United States with an inadmissible noncitizen minor. The adult attempted to smuggle the inadmissible noncitizen minor into the United States from Mexico using a birth certificate that was not issued lawfully to the minor. Once again, the reason for the detention was to maintain family unity during the processing of the noncitizen. In both cases, the U.S. citizen adults were charged with 8 U.S.C. § 1324, *Bringing in and harboring certain aliens*, and the adult and U.S. citizen minor were admitted into the United States. The inadmissible noncitizen minors were placed with the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Refugee Resettlement, as required by law.
